LOCATION

Assabah Arts and Science College is situated very close to the Kuttippuram -Thrissur State Highway at Valayamkulam., Kokkur in the Alamkode Panchayath of Malappuram District. The belt, Valayamkulam, Chalissery, Kadavallur forms the confluence of three Districts namely Malappuram, Palakkad, Thrissur. The college is just 2 kilometers away from Changaramkulam.



GENERAL RULES

- Students must wear uniform, identity card etc. properly to enter the
 college campus. Students who do not wear uniform will not be
 permitted to enter the campus and they will not be admitted to the
 class as well under any circumstances. In case of any emergency,
 the parent may inform the class teacher in advance and get the
 permission to enter the class. Students must wear the identity card
 inside the college and the class.
- Class time will be from 9.30 am to 3.30 pm. with five periods of one hour duration and lunch break from 12.30pm to 1.30pm.
- 3. All students must reach the class on time and need attend every period of the day. Otherwise, it will affect their attendance and internal marks of the courses they attend in a semester. Students without 75% attendance will not be allowed to register for university examinations, unless otherwise they condone for shortage of attendance.
- 4. No students will be allowed to sit inside the campus after 4.30 pm after the class. Students participating in sports, arts and other extracurricular activities controlled and managed by respective faculties are allowed to remain within the campus with the permission and responsibility of their respective teachers in charge.
- 5. Give teachers, non-teaching staff and fellow students due respect.
- Do not engage any activities which may cause damage to the property, or if any student is found to be involved in making any damage or harm to the property of the college a sufficient fine will be imposed upon him or her to make good the loss.
- Any type of harassment/ Ragging is strictly prohibited with in the campus. The college shall initiate stringent, disciplinary action against those who violate the rules in force in this regard.
- 8. No political activity of any kind is allowed inside the college. Political flags, political rally, dharna, slogans etc. are completely prohibited as per direction from Honorable High Court of Kerala. Hence college authority will be enforced to initiate disciplinary action against those who violate High Court verdict in this regard.



- The College Union election shall be conducted in parliamentary mode as per university rules and regulations under the strict direction of the election officials appointed to conduct union elections.
- Students are strictly prohibited from entering the college wearing T shirt.
- 11. Students should pay the semester fees on time as per the instructions given from the office. Failure to do so will invite removal of the name from the nominal roll and subsequent suspension of exam registration.
- 12. Students arriving late will not be admitted to the college under any circumstances. However, in case of any exigency, he or she may contact via call the respective class teacher before 9.15 am.
- 13. Students are not allowed to use mobile phones in the classroom under any circumstances.
- 14. No private celebration of any kind is allowed inside the class or college.
- 15. All students should take special care to keep their classrooms neat and tidy.
- 16. Students are warned to the drug abuse with in the campus. In any case, if any intoxicant is found to be used by any student or group of student stringent disciplinary actions will be initiated against the accused.
- Students who use two-wheelers will be allowed parking facilities of the college only if they comply with all the documents as per direction from RTO.
- 18. Students should comply with rules and regulations in force to satisfy their academic performance required for the internal marks in parameters such as attendance, submission of assignment, seminar presentation, internal examination etc., required for the award of internal marks in every course of their study in a semester.
- 19. Students should bring their own textbooks, pens, pencils, notebooks, calculators, and other learning materials.
- 20. If students need to take leave under any circumstances, they must inform the respective class teacher. If it is a situation where leave is required for more than three days, permission should be taken from the principal, via the class teacher. Students who take leave for more than 15 consecutive days without a clear reason will be removed from the nominal roll.
- 21. Students must reach the examination hall on time for the university examination. Any malpractice found in the examination hall shall be subject to disciplinary action as prescribed by the University.
- 22. Students participating in Arts, Sports etc. should practice the same in the allotted time and ensure attendance in the remaining classes. Otherwise, the attendance during the practice will be forfeited.
- 23. Students going for any program at university level are allowed to go for the said program only with the permission of the program coordinator, HOD, class teacher etc.
- 24. No fire works shall be permitted within the campus.
- 25. Use of different color dusts and spraying the same on others, as part of any celebration, will not be permitted and disciplinary actions will be initiated against those who violate the rules.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- University of Calicut introduces Centralized admission process for admission to UG & PG Programmes in its affiliated colleges.
- The candidate should apply online to the university of Calicut under the single windows system prior to notified date. www.cuonline.ac.in
- 3. Admission is done as per the Guidelines of University of calicut.
- 4. Online registration under CAP ID (Centralised Admission Process) is compulsory for both UG & PG admission.
- 5. For admission under management quota, the candidate should apply with CAP ID in the Application form issued by the institute.
- College application form for admission under management quata can be had from the college office on payment of Rs.100/- in person. Other mode of transactions will not be accepted.
- Separate application form is necessary for UG and PG programmes under management and sports quata.
- Attested copies of mark lists of qualifying examination should be submitted during admission.
- All the Candidate should produce the CAP print out and allotment memo at the time of admission (those who intimate genuine reason will be considered another date)
- The candidates who do not appear for the interview on the day fixed in the allotment memo will not be eliqible for admission.
- 11. Admission will be finalized only after the interview.
- 12. The parent/guardian should be present at the time of interview.

FOR THE MANAGEMENT QUOTA ADMISSION

- Candidate can obtain application form from college office.
- Submission of an application does not guarantee of admission.
- Submit the application in the prescribed form. Make sure that no column is left blank.
- Information for admission to management seat will be available at the college office.
- The college will intimate you if you are selected for admission.

Elective course:


Means a course, which can be substituted, by equivalent course from the same subject and a minimum number of courses are required to complete the programme.
