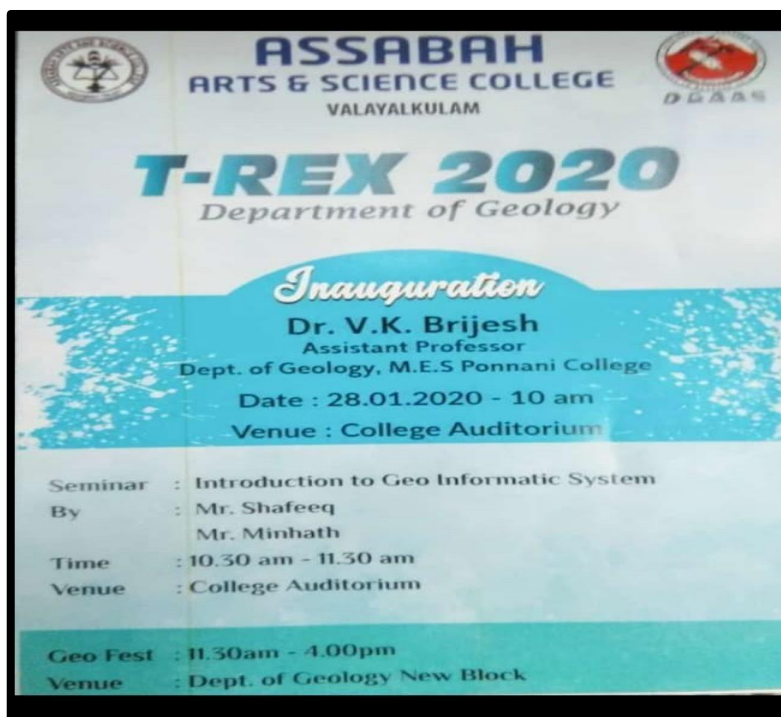

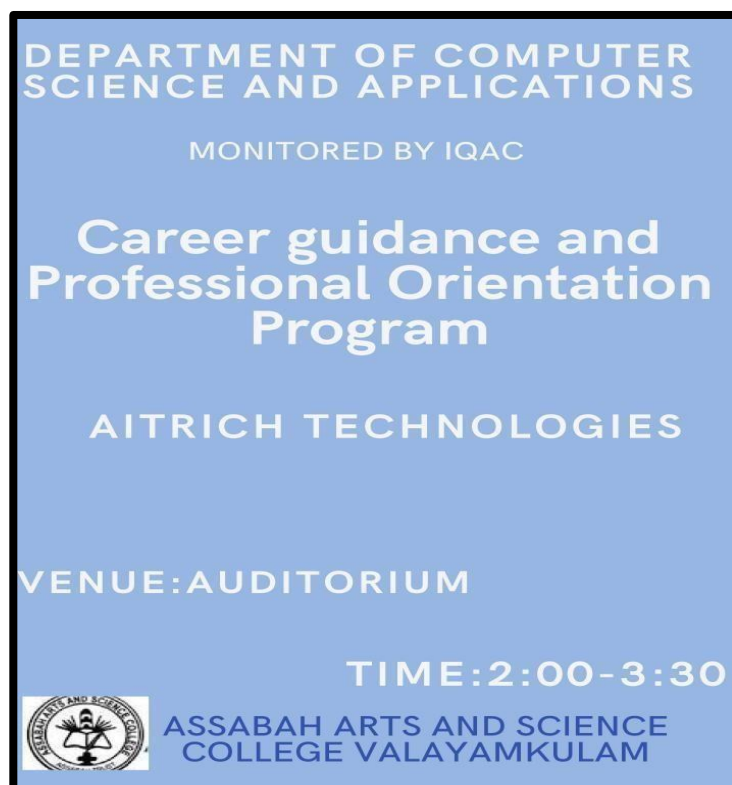
### **SOFT SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM**
