## **WEBINAR ON “FINDING DIGITAL OPPORTUNITIES”**

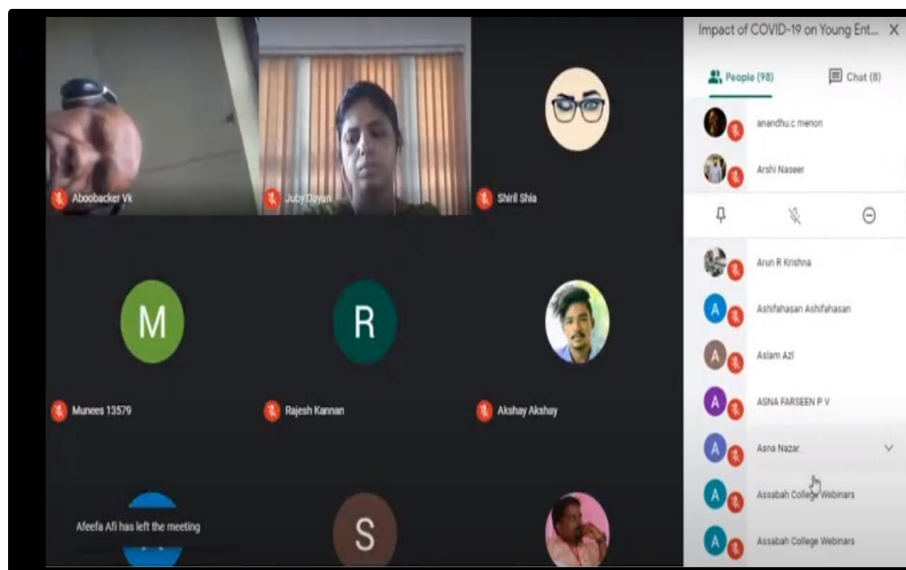


## ONLINE WEBINAR
