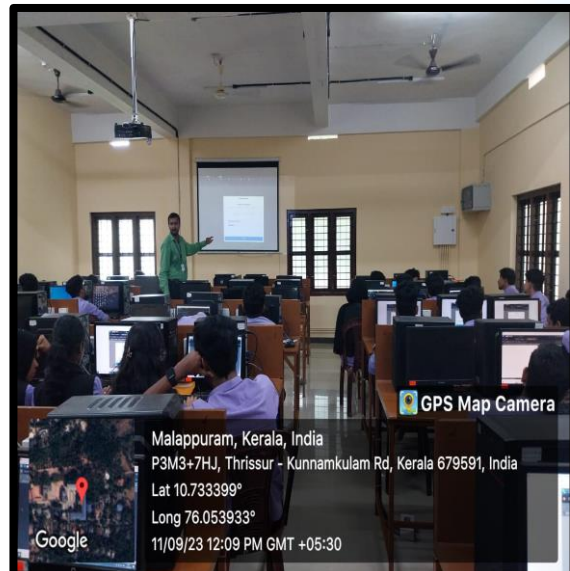

OTHER FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

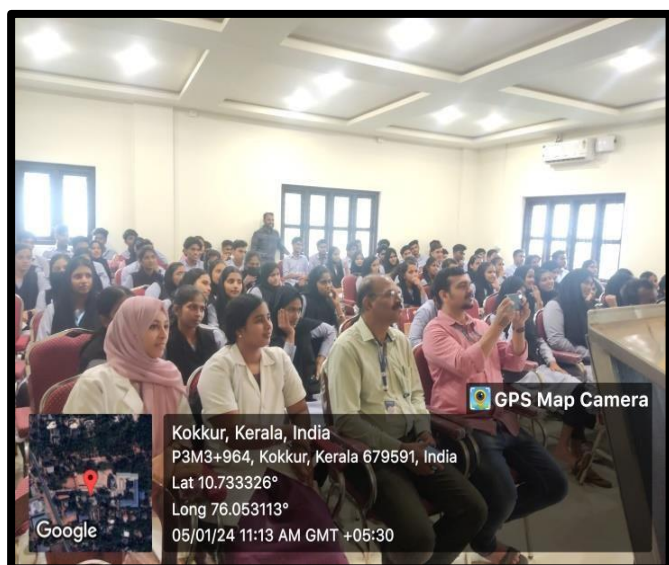

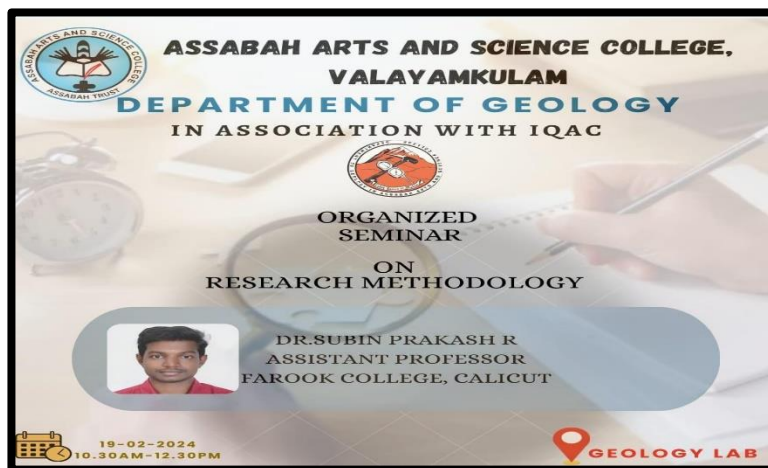

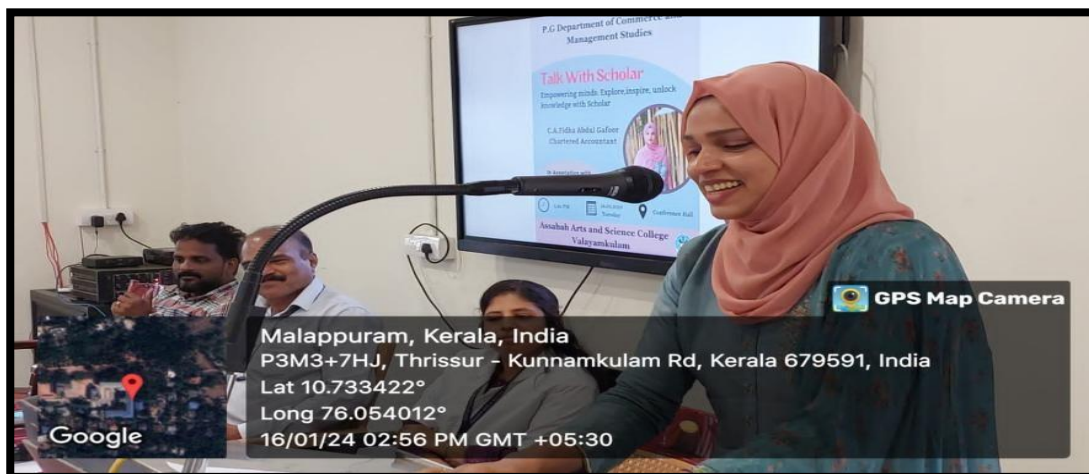
