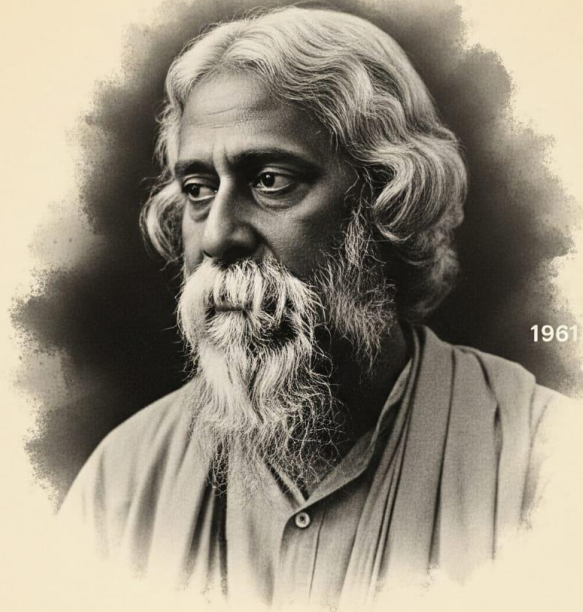

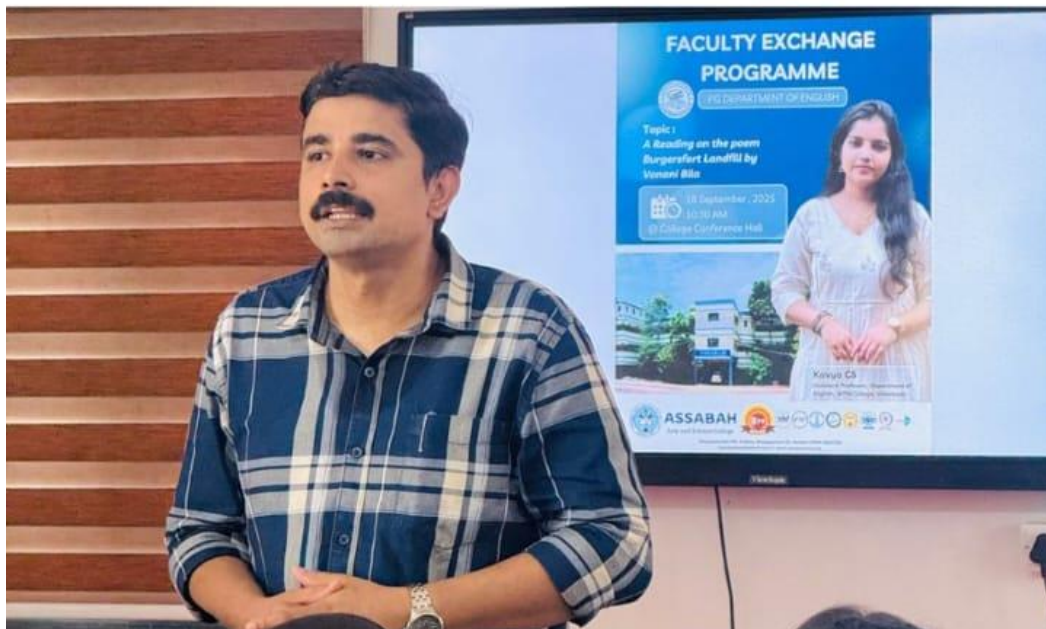

Outcome and Conclusion

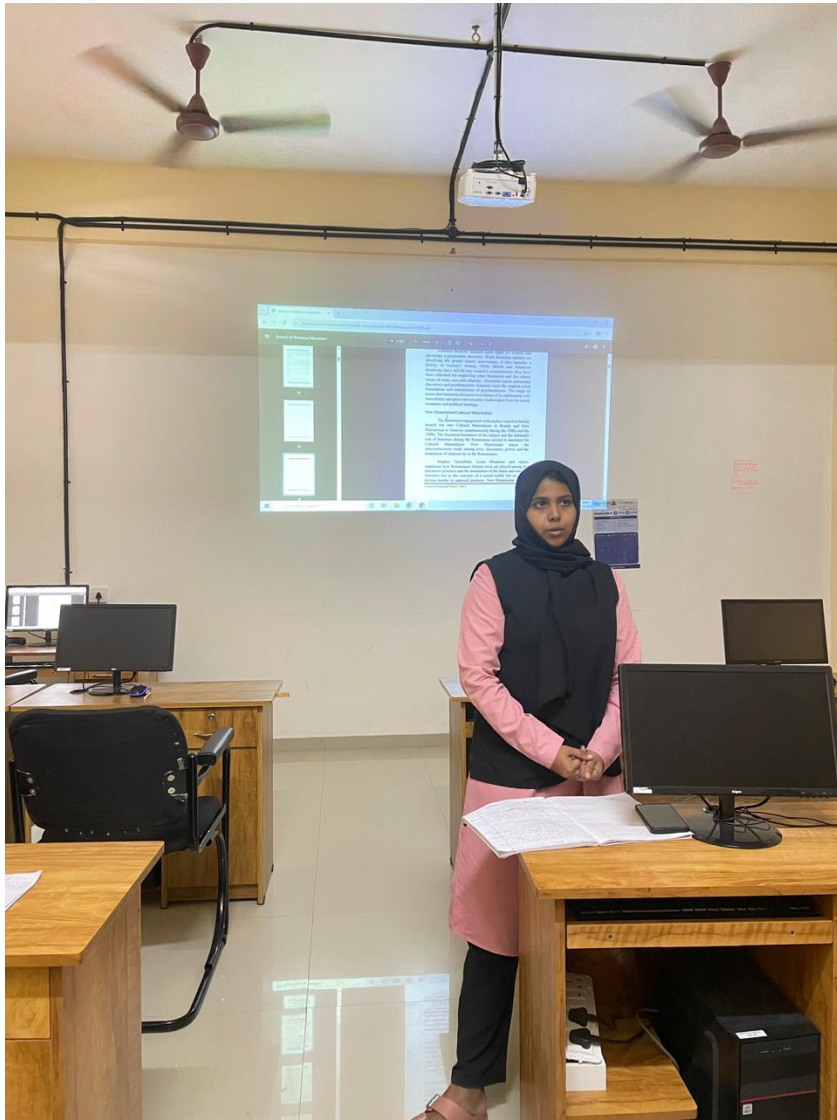

On November 18, 2025, the Department of English organized "Focus Fit," a specialized mind strengthening session designed specifically for the outgoing Sixth Semester BA English batch. The session was led by Ms. Afeefa, a noted Psychologist.

Key Objectives:

To equip students with psychological tools to handle final semester academic pressure.

To improve concentration and mental resilience.

To provide strategies for anxiety management regarding future career paths.

Session Highlights:

Ms. Afeefa engaged the students with interactive techniques focused on "mental fitness." She emphasized that just as the body needs exercise, the mind requires specific training to stay focused. Key topics discussed included:

The Science of Focus: Understanding how digital distractions affect cognitive load.

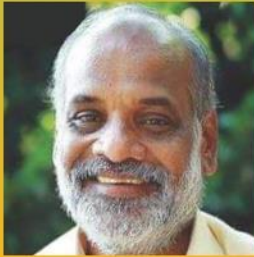
